(and what you should consider getting yourself)**

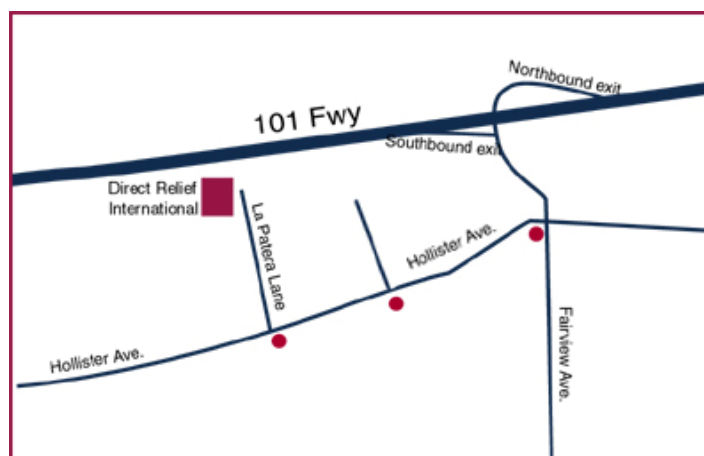
Direct Relief International, and Foodbank of Santa Barbara
